- Don't change your tone of voice when you see us or when we come in the room
- Don't touch our property or move our equipment without asking (for example: a person in a wheelchair who gets moved by staff without asking)
- Don't ask someone else what we want ask us
- Don't have meetings about us without us
- Don't talk to us in a bossy way
- Don't talk to us in a "cute" tone of voice
- Don't discount our abilities
- Don't think that people with disabilities are all the same—we are all different, including you
- Don't patronize us
